## OFFICIAL RULES OF THE 2019 CRC FISHING RODEO

YOU MUST HAVE A CRC WRISTBAND TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS RODEO.

1. RODEO: Starts at 6:00 a.m. Friday, June 7th and ends at 3:00 p.m. Saturday, June 8, 2019.
2. Registration fees must be paid by June 1, 2019.
3. Fish may be caught on rod and reel on any boat or pier in the Delacroix, La immediate area.
4. Entries must be caught during posted rodeo hours and must be weighed at 6305 Delacroix Hwy. by the designated weigh master. You must be in line with your catch by 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 8th to enter your catch.
5. Scales open at Weigh-in location on Saturday 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. No exceptions. The line for the weigh-in scales will close promptly at 3:00 p.m. and no further entries will be accepted. All those physically in the weigh-in line WITH THEIR ENTRIES at 3:00 p.m. shall be allowed to weigh their entries.
6. Fish must be kept on ice to prevent spoilage. No frozen, drawn, chemically treated, or spoiled fish will be accepted. The designated weigh master will inspect all entries for compliance. The Rules Committee will make any final determination of entry eligibility. Rules Committee rulings on fish eligibility are final and not subject to appeal.
7. All entries must comply with applicable Louisiana State Laws and Salt Water Regulations—no illegal entries will be accepted. The Rodeo will not be responsible for the possession of illegal species or size by the contestants.
8. In the event of a tie in any category, the first fish weighed in will be declared the winner.
9. The largest fish will be determined by weight.
10. Eligible species of fish and permit requirements subject to change depending upon applicable laws.
11. WEATHER: In the event that weather conditions arise and are deemed unsafe by the tournament officials, the tournament may be called off for that day. No refunds will be made in the event of cancellation.
12. All prizes must be collected by winning anglers within thirty (30) days of the award ceremony.

### RODEO FEES

- \$40 until 11:59 p.m. June 1, 2019.
- Kids 16 and under must fish in the Jr. Angler division (\$10 for up to 4 kids and registered with parent) unless they paid an entry fee of \$40 or above.
- ALL DECISIONS OF THE RODEO RULES COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL.



#### OPEN DIVISION

- Open to all anglers. Anglers must be registered for the Open Division and pay entry fee as stated above.
- One trophy will be awarded in the following categories:
  - Largest Red Fish
  - Largest Trout
  - Largest Bass
  - Largest Sheep Head
  - 2 Red Fish Under 27"
  - Red Fish With The Most Spots

#### JUNIOR DIVISION

- Open to all anglers 16 years of age and under. All fish MUST be caught unassisted. ONE trophy will be awarded in the following categories: Largest Red Fish, Largest Trout, Largest Non-Red Fish
- Junior anglers competing in the Junior Division are not eligible for prizes in any other division unless they have purchased a rodeo ticket to enter the Open Division by paying the required fee.
- All junior entries will comply with applicable Louisiana State Laws and Salt Water and Fresh Water Regulations.
- Anglers 16-years and under who participate in the Junior Division are not eligible for trophies in the Open Division unless they register in the Open Division.

#### HOLD HARMLESS

It is expressly understood that all registered participants and non-registered enter at their own risk. Further, each registered and non-registered participant on behalf of other family members and/or executors agrees to release and hold harmless the tournament officials, sponsors, and all other persons connected directly or indirectly with operation of said tournament from any liability for libel, slander, loss, damage, negligence, harm, injury, or death suffered by any participant, entrant, sport fishermen, their companions, boat captains, mates, crew members, vessels and equipment which may occur during the tournament.

#### MINORS

Parents of legal guardians of anglers who are under the age of 18 and competing in the Rodeo, must review all of the rules and regulations governing the tournament and sign on behalf of their child.

#### PROTESTS

Any protest made must be made in writing, accompanied by a \$300 protest fee, and in the hands of the Tournament Committee prior to 5:30 pm on the tournament day. All decisions and ruling by the Tournament Committee decisions regarding any protests are final and binding. All participants and boats shall exercise good sportsmanship and courtesy (whether at dock, underway or fishing) or may be subject to disqualification without refund. All decisions will rest with the Tournament Committee and such decisions will be final. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject any registration, for any reason.

RULES MAY CHANGE SLIGHTLY IF DISCREPANCIES ARE FOUND PRIOR TO TOURNAMENT. REGISTERED ANGLERS WILL BE SENT AN EMAIL WITH THE RULES ATTACHED.
